**Friday, February 19<sup>th</sup>**

**10 – 11am Children’s Hour** – Susan Fitzgerald will lead this lively exploration of the labyrinth for children. We’ll explore moving our bodies as a way to interpret any number of things: animals, events, ideas and emotions. Parental/caregiver participation invited.

**11am – 12pm Children’s Quiet Hour** – Intended for those children (and their adults) who would like to move into a more spiritual experience.

**12 Noon - 8pm Open Walk** – Join us for individual walking meditation during any of the “Open Walk” times. A Labyrinth Host will be present to welcome you and answer questions. Come at any point and stay as long as you like.

**Saturday, February 20<sup>th</sup>**

**9 - 11am Labyrinth 101** – Trisha Kibbe of the New England Labyrinth Guild will lead this workshop. Come learn about the origins and history of the labyrinth and walk in community. We will then spend time sharing our experience.

**11am – 4pm Open Walk** – see Friday description.

**1 - 3:30pm Right Brain/Left Brain and the Labyrinth and Mandalas** – Tricia Kibbe will lead discussion on how the labyrinth can affect our thought processes. We will then make personal mandalas, walk the labyrinth, and share the experience.

**Sunday, February 21<sup>st</sup>**

**10—11am Worship & Church School** - Dedication of the Labyrinth Ministry in worship. Children may walk the labyrinth during church school as part of their experience of prayer.

**11:30—12:00 Introduction to the Labyrinth** – Susan Fitzgerald will lead a 30 minute presentation of labyrinth use and its history in the Chapel. Participants may walk the labyrinth following the presentation.

**11:15 – 4pm Open Walk** – see Friday description.
